Minimum Playing Time (Half Game Law):

Applies to ALL teams in the 2nd XV Section 1 and 2nd XV Section 2 Grades (Grading Rounds)

All players in the named squad of 22 players each playing Saturday at all levels below Secondary School First XV **grades** are required to play half of a game each match. There will be no rolling subs. At halftime any reserves that are present must take to the field before the second half starts. This also applies to representative games at levels Under 16 and below.

Secondary School Girls pushing in the scrum:

First XV Secondary School Girls rugby can push up to 1.5 metres as per IRB Under 19 Law.
